GUIDELINES FOR VISITOR BEHAVIOUR AT CULTURAL SITES AND IN VULNERABLE AREAS.



Be polite to locals and respect their privacy, traditions, and customs.



Ask for permission before taking photos of people or private property.



Preserve natural areas; do not disturb plants or animals, and refrain from picking flowers or damaging trees. Feeding animals is prohibited unless explicitly allowed.



Take your trash with you or dispose of it in designated bins. By separating waste, you help keep the environment clean and friendly for everyone.



Stay on marked paths and respect information signs and instructions.



Avoid loud behavior that could disturb wildlife and other visitors.



Camping and overnight stays are only allowed at designated locations. Only light fires in designated areas, if permitted.



Avoid touching sensitive parts of monuments, artworks, or objects unless allowed.



Adhere to the visiting hours of attractions and purchase tickets in advance if required.

Purchase local products and services to contribute to the development of the area.
